

**ANNOUNCEMENT No. 10/2025**

The Director of the Mineral and Energy Economy Research Institute of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Krakow announces an open competition for the position of Professor in the field of research on strategic management of processes and products, with particular emphasis on the principles of the circular economy, in the DIVISION OF STRATEGIC RESEARCH.

Candidates should meet the conditions set out in Article 89, paragraph 1 of the Act on the Polish Academy of Sciences of 30 April 2010, as amended.

**Requirements:**

- academic title of Professor in the field of Social Sciences, in the discipline of Management and Quality Studies,
- recognized scholarly achievements and scientific standing,
- active participation in scientific life (participation in national and international conferences and symposia, involvement in national and international organizations and scientific societies, organization of conferences, symposia, seminars, and maintaining international collaborations),
- contribution to expert and advisory activities (reviews of doctoral and habilitation theses, monographs, articles, research studies, and other works),
- proven experience in leading research projects,
- documented organizational achievements.

An additional advantage will be:

- significant scientific achievements in the field of mineral resource management, including business models for the circular economy, eco-efficiency of investments, application of life cycle assessment (LCA) and life cycle cost (LCC) methods, and corporate social responsibility (CSR).

**When applying for the competition, the following documents must be submitted:**

1. Application for employment addressed to the Director of the Institute with a signed information clause (Annex 1).
2. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
3. Document confirming the title of professor in the field of social sciences, in the discipline of Environmental Engineering, Mining and Energy.
4. Information concerning scientific and organizational activities in compliance with the competition requirements.
5. A list of publications and projects.
6. A declaration of acceptance of the competition terms.

1. Full-time employment.
2. Employment period: indefinite term starting **1<sup>st</sup> December 2025**.

In the event of winning the competition and taking up employment, the originals of the documents will be required.

5. The competition results will be announced on **23<sup>rd</sup> October 2025**.

### Information clause

In accordance with the Act of May 10, 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) and in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

3. Your personal data will be processed only for the purpose of conducting a competition for the position of a professor in the DIVISION OF STRATEGIC RESEARCH – the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is art. 6 sec. 1 letter c of the GDPR.
4. You have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify it, the right to request deletion, processing restrictions, the right to transfer data, the right to object to the processing of data, the right to withdraw consent (if granted) at any time without giving any reason, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
5. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but failure to do so makes it impossible for you to consider your application.
6. From the moment of obtaining your personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purpose indicated in point. 3, and thereafter for a specified period in the provisions of the Act of July 14, 1983 on the national archival resource and archives (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 553).
7. Your personal data will not be shared with other entities (administrators), except for entities authorized under the law. The administrator will not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.
8. The data administrator does not profile you.
9. You have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory body – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Warsaw, ul. Stawki 2), if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
