Candidates must meet the conditions set out in Article 89, paragraph 4. Act on the Polish Academy of Sciences of April 30, 2010, with subsequent changes.

Requirements:

- post-doctoral degree (D. Sc.) in the field of engineering and technical sciences, in the discipline of Environmental Engineering, Mining and Energy,
- experience in research programs (national research projects, EU research projects, statutory research, own research, research for industry),
- active participation in scientific life (participation in national and international conferences and symposia, membership in national and international scientific societies, organization of conferences, symposia, seminars, and maintaining international contacts),
- participation in expert and advisory activities (reviews, expert reports, opinions, etc.),
- · engagement in organizational activities.

An additional advantage will be:

- significant scientific achievements in the field of power engineering, including renewable energy, energy storage, the hydrogen economy, and modelling of fuel and energy systems,
- experience in managing and implementing projects and expertise for public institutions or enterprises from the power sector,
- a certificate confirming knowledge of English or another congress language (German, French, Spanish, Russian, Italian) at a level of at least C1,
- experience in using software tools such as GAMS, Matlab, and Python.

- 5. A list of publications, projects, or research services.
- 6. Evaluation of scientific achievements prepared by at least one independent academic staff member from outside the employing institution.
- 7. A statement declaring that the Institute will be the candidate's primary place of employment (if the competition is won).
- 8. A declaration of acceptance of the competition terms.
