

ANNOUCEMENT No. 9/2025

The Director of the Mineral and Energy Economy Research Institute of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Krakow, announces an open competition for the position of research assistant in the field of mathematical modeling of energy systems and data analysis in the DIVISION OF ENERGY ECONOMICS.

Candidates should meet the conditions set out in Article 89, paragraph 4. Act on the Polish Academy of Sciences of April 30, 2010, with subsequent changes.

Requirements:

- a master's degree in the field of engineering and technical sciences, in the discipline of Environmental Engineering, Mining and Energy, or Automatics, Electronics, Electrical Engineering and Space Technologies
- a certificate confirming proficiency in English or another congress language (German, French, Spanish, Russian, Italian) at a level of at least B2,
- demonstrating an aptitude for scientific research.

An additional advantage will be:

- experience in programming and modeling energy systems using mathematical modeling environments,
- ability to build optimization models in the GAMS/CPLEX mathematical modeling environment,
- proficiency in data analysis using Python,
- proficiency in geospatial data analysis using QGIS,
- proficiency in using MS Office tools (especially MS Excel, MS Word, and MS PowerPoint),
- scientific or science-popularization activity.

When applying for the competition, the following documents must be submitted:

1. Application for employment addressed to the Director of the Institute with a signed information clause (Annex 1).
2. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
3. Document confirming the professional title of Master of Science in Engineering in the field of Engineering and Technical Sciences, in the discipline of Environmental Engineering, Mining, and Energy.
4. A certificate confirming proficiency in a foreign language as specified in the requirements.
5. A recommendation letter from a researcher confirming the candidate's aptitude for scientific work.
6. A statement declaring that the Mineral and Energy Economy Research Institute will be the candidate's primary place of employment (if the competition is won).
7. A declaration of acceptance of the competition terms.

1. Full-time employment.
2. Employment period: indefinite term starting **1st December 2025**.
3. Candidates are requested to submit their applications for the competition exclusively by e-mail to: centrum@min-pan.krakow.pl, with the annotation **Competition - Announcement No. 9/2025**.
Scans of the required documents must be attached to the application.
In the event of winning the competition and taking up employment, the originals of the documents will be required.
4. The deadline for submitting documents is **22nd October 2025**.
5. The competition results will be announced on **23rd October 2025**.

Information clause

In accordance with the Act of May 10, 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) and in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

3. Your personal data will be processed only for the purpose of conducting a competition for the position of a research assistant in the DIVISION OF ENERGY ECONOMICS – the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is art. 6 sec. 1 letter c of the GDPR.
4. You have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify it, the right to request deletion, processing restrictions, the right to transfer data, the right to object to the processing of data, the right to withdraw consent (if granted) at any time without giving any reason, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
5. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but failure to do so makes it impossible for you to consider your application.
6. From the moment of obtaining your personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purpose indicated in point. 3, and thereafter for a specified period in the provisions of the Act of July 14, 1983 on the national archival resource and archives (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 553).
7. Your personal data will not be shared with other entities (administrators), except for entities authorized under the law. The administrator will not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.
8. The data administrator does not profile you.
9. You have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory body – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Warsaw, ul. Stawki 2), if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
